## Phlebotomy Admissions Checklist-2023-24

Applicants to the Fletcher's Phlebotomy Program must complete and submit the following information order to apply. If at any point, the candidate does not comply with any part of this process, the candidate will not be eligible for the program and will have to re-apply for a future clinical class. All applicants must submit all of the following:

- Complete an admissions application to Fletcher Technical Community College (current/continuing Fletcher students do not need to submit another application) online at www.fletcher.edu.
- 2. Be fully or unconditionally accepted to Fletcher Technical Community College by completing all admissions requirements. Admissions will notify you of your status via email.
- 3. Complete and submit an "Application for Admissions to a Nursing & Allied Health Programs" located on the Fletcher website → Programs → Phlebotomy
- 4. Copy of High School Diploma or GED/HiSet transcripts requested and sent to Fletcher Department of Nursing and Allied Health 1407 Hwy 311 Schriever, LA 70395. If on file with Admissions, students may upload a statement saying "My scores/transcripts are at Fletcher".
- 5. Complete a Louisiana State Police Background Check. Instructions can be found by clicking <a href="here">here</a>.

Proof of the following is not required for application, but must be submitted upon acceptance into the program:

- Current TB test, or clear chest x-rays.
- Physical
- Negative drug screen.
- Current (does not expire prior to the end of the semester) American Heart Association Basic Life Support certification. If you are not currently certified, you can register for an upcoming class by clicking <a href="here">here</a>.
- Immunization records (must include):
  - o 2 MMR shots (measles, mumps, and rubella),
  - a current tetanus
  - o diphtheria (TD) shot within the last 10 years
  - HEP B series must be started,
  - o current flu vaccine,
  - o COVID-19 vaccination
