The information and recommendations on this form coincide with the Grievance Policy in the Student Handbook found at www.fletcher.edu
A sincere attempt must be made to follow the Informal Grievance procedures before filing a formal grievance.

INFORMAL: If your grievance involves discrimination on the basis of sex, race or disability, please see the Director of Retention. For grievance against another student, you may request mediation from the Dean of Student Affairs. For grievance against a faculty member, you are strongly encouraged to speak to the faculty member first. If no resolution is reached, speak to the faculty member's Dept. Head. If you need further mediation, speak to the faculty member's Dean. For grievance against a staff member, speak to that person's direct supervisor. If you need further mediation, refer to the staff member's Dean or Dept. Head. If no resolution is reached, the final procedure for an Informal Grievance is to meet with the Dean of Student Affairs.

FORMAL: If after pursuing all above stated avenues, the grievance is not resolved, use this form to begin a formal grievance within 5 days following the end of the informal grievance proceedings. Form is to be turned in to the Dean of Student Affairs.
