- Attend and provide meaningful instruction for all class and clinical sessions during the semester. Be punctual in class attendance and provide instruction for the complete class period. Make appropriate arrangements for necessary absences according to College policies.
- Evaluate present clinical facilities and meet with agency personnel to review objectives of clinical experience.
- Maintain accurate attendance, progress, and evaluation records in an acceptable grade book format and file these grade books (photocopies/print-outs) with the registrar at the end of each semester.
- Supervise students in the clinical area and assist students to develop critical thinking skills.
- Provide classroom instruction in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, College harassment policies, and/or other legal requirements.
- Keep minimum office hours.

Qualifications: For the RN program: A Master's degree in Nursing with competence as a practitioner in OB and/or Pediatrics. Candidates must have good instructional techniques; computer knowledge; student-centered attitude; and must be well organized
