Medical Laboratory Technician Adjunct Instructor

The Medical Laboratory Technician will be able to:

- The medical laboratory technician is qualified by academic and applied science education to provide service in clinical laboratory science and related areas in rapidly changing and dynamic healthcare delivery systems.
- Medical laboratory technicians perform, evaluate, correlate and assure accuracy and validity of laboratory information; direct and supervise clinical laboratory resources and operations; and collaborate in the diagnosis and treatment of patients.
- The medical laboratory technician has diverse and multi-level functions in the areas of collecting, processing, and analyzing biological specimens and other substances, principles and methodologies, performance of assays, problem solving, troubleshooting techniques, significance of clinical procedures and results, principles and practices of quality assessment, for all major areas practiced in the contemporary clinical laboratory.
- Medical laboratory technicians practice independently and collaboratively, being responsible for their own actions, as defined by the profession. They have the requisite knowledge and skills to educate laboratory professionals, other health care professionals, and others in laboratory practice as well as the public.
- The ability to relate to people, a capacity for calm and reasoned judgment and a demonstration of commitment to the patient are essential qualities. Communications skills extend to consultative interactions with members of the healthcare team, external relations, customer service and patient education. Laboratory professionals demonstrate ethical and moral attitudes and principles that are necessary for gaining and maintaining the confidence of patients, professional associates, and the community.
- The candidate must demonstrate knowledge and proficiency in their content areas.
- The candidate must participate in teaching in specialty areas, student evaluation, and development of course content and assessment of student learning outcomes.

Qualifications:

Education Requirements Include:

- The Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners requires a certification (ASCP or equivalent) as a Medical Laboratory Technician (or CLT, and they must be licensed as such).
- When they apply for the MLT (CLT) license, they have to show proof of the completed degree as well as proof of passing the ASCP Board of certification.
- Hold a medical Laboratory Technician Certification and professional licensure.
- Have a least one year experience as a practicing MLT in one of the following areas:
 - Laboratory Procedures and Management
 - Hematology/coagulation/Immunology
 - Microbiology/parasitology
 - Chemistry/Urinalysis/Body Fluids
 - Immunohematology/Blood Bank
